Each week, Charlie and his crew load up their gear which includes a lot of heavy equipment and head out to Godknows-where. They tear down log cabins, barns, churches, old mills, whatever needs to be removed. It's not easy. This is not run-of-the-mill demolition work. The locations are usually far from main roads. There's no electricity. There's nor unning water —and no bathrooms. Charlie and the boys are completely on their own.
